In 2019 we increased the volume of food rescued by 46%, were runners up in the Observer Best Ethical Food Project category for the second year running, fed and educated 49 children from 22 families with the Happy Healthy Holidays scheme, racked up 12,500 miles in our van and 300 on our cargo bikes, and saw several volunteers move into paid employment - congratulations to them!
